Years ago, the J.C. Penney stores were among the world's largest chains of dry goods stores with 1700 branches in the United States, but few people know about one of the most important events in the life of its founder, J. C. Penney.

In the market crash of 1929 Penny suffered a financial and emotional setback. A combination of circumstances had broken him so completely, physically and mentally that he was overwhelmed with the fear of death.

While in the hospital, the great business tycoon heard singing coming from the hospital Chapel. It was the hymn "God Will Take Care of You." Mr. Penny was deeply moved and considered that experience as if God were talking to his specific need to get control of his life. He realized that he alone was responsible for all his troubles. From then on, his life was free from worry. He later wrote, "The most dramatic and glorious minutes of my life were those I spent in the Chapel that morning when I heard that hymn: "God Will Take Care of You."

William Gladstone on being questioned about his serenity was able to maintain in spite of substantial stresses declared: "At the foot of my bed, where I can see it on retiring, and on arising in the morning, are the words: "Thou will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on thee, because he trusts in Thee." (Isa. 26:3) The apostle Paul was able to handle the greatest fear of all when he looked death in the face and wrote, "So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immorality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, "Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?" (I Cor. 15:54-55)

Only the Christian can heed the advice of William Cullen Bryant:

So live that when thy summons comes to join
The innumerable caravan which moves
To that mysterious realm, where each shall take
His chamber in the silent halls of death,
Thou go not, like the quarry-slave at night,
Scourged to his dungeon, but, sustained and soothed
By an unfaltering trust, approach thy grave,
Like one that wraps the drapery of his couch
About him, and lies down to pleasant dreams.
