"I am the Good Shepherd, and know my sheep, and I am known of mine."

John 10:14

The popular song, "It Is No Secret," was written and recorded by Stewart Hamlin in 1950. He was one of radio's first "Singing Cowboys."

After a conversion experience which resulted in what he described as a change in his "destructive habits," Hamlin changed his life's goals and directed his attention toward God and all things good. Even his subsequent songs included Biblical themes. (For example, he also wrote, "Until Then.")

Here is how "It Is No Secret" came to be written: While he and his wife visited in a friend's home – a fellow western star – Hamlin shared his new-found goals and the joy in the direction his new lifestyle was taking him! In the course of the conversation, he expressed to his friend how amazed he was that a person can solve even the most serious conflicts and problems! He added, "It is no secret what God can do in a man's life!"

About two hours later, as the Hamlins were leaving to go home, his friend suggested, "Stewart, why don't you write a song about it not being a secret what God can do in a person's life? That is a beautiful thought!"

When the Hamlins arrived home, he went immediately to his piano to begin writing the lyrics to 'It Is No Secret." Just then, his clock in the hallway began to chime the midnight hour so he began the song with the words, "The chimes of time ring out the news, another day is through." The first verse of a song which has been recorded many times by the most popular singers. (Incidentally, it is # 493 in our hymnal) If you don't know the tune, next time you pick up the book, just be blessed by reading the words to, "It Is No Secret!"

And, who was his friend who suggested he write the song? None other than John Wayne!
