LIVING INSIDE OUT

A wise man's heart is at his right hand, but a fool's heart at his left."

Ecclesiastes 10:2

If you have ever read this verse, you have probably wondered, "What in the world is Solomon talking about? What does this verse mean?"

One of the best ways to understand a verse is to look at various translations. The verse just quoted is from the King James Version (KJV) New International Version (NIV) "The heart of the wise inclines to the right, but the heart of a fool is to the left." New American Standard Version: (NASV) "A wise man's heart directs him toward the right, but the foolish man's heart directs him toward the left." The Living Bible: A wise man's heart leads him to do right, and a fool's heart leads him to do evil." There – does the verse have more meaning to you now?

From these translations, one may conclude that Solomon is referring to a manner of life. The wise man chooses to follow the will of God while the fool determines to do evil. It appears, then, that it is what we are on the inside that determines what we are on the outside! "As a man thinks in his heart, so is he." (Prov. 23:7) Jesus taught His disciples in Matthew 23:2 that they were to follow the teachings of the Pharisees and those who taught the law. But He warned them: "Therefore, whatever they tell you observe and do, but do not do according to their works: for they say, and do not do."

In verses 27 & Desus said to the scribes and Pharisees, "Hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness. Even so you outwardly appear righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness." Be reminded that God said, "The Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks upon the heart." (I Sam. 16:5)

What we are on the INSIDE is what is going to happen to us on the OUTSIDE! In other words, the inside influences the outside! Remember, God sees and knows what we are on the inside!

The outcome of our life will be determined by whether we are bigger on the inside than we are on the outside, and not by what we appear to be by others! So, let's follow David's plea in prayer to God: "Create in me a clean heart O God, and renew a right spirit within me." (Ps.51:10)

"ON THE FRONT LINE!"

After the Battles at Shiloh on April 6 and 7 of 1862, the fields and woods above Pittsburg Landing, along the Tennessee River, were covered with thousands of dead and wounded soldiers from both sides!

A soldier from Iowa later wrote, "The battlefields were among the most heart rendering sights it was ever my lot to witness! For miles, the ground was strewn with the mangled bodies of the dead and dying."

At sundown on April 7, Battery Commander Captain Andrew Warren, a Union Officer, entered his battered tent and discovered a body of a Confederate corpse and a young Union officer who was severely wounded. The Captain would later record these details:

"As I raised his head and placed my canteen to his parched lips, the last faint rays of the setting sun came struggling through the pines and illuminated, as with a halo, the face of that dying lad. Suddenly arousing himself, in whispered voice, he said: "Please, Sir – tell my mother where you found me. . .

...on the front line!"

In this soldier's dying moment, his last breath on earth; the thing that concerned him most, was that his mother be assured he had died while doing his duty on the front line of battle!

Likewise, you and I are in a battle with our arch enemy – Satan! But ours is a spiritual battle. "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against spiritual wickedness in high places." (Eph. 6:12)

We are to live and serve as "good soldiers of Jesus Christ." (2 Tim. 3:3) Paul instructed Timothy to "Fight the good fight of faith." (1 Tim. 6:12)

As a faithful soldier on the front lines of a life-long battle between temptation and sin, the "victory that overcomes the world, even our faith (I John 5:4) will strengthen our determination to be deemed faithful as we stand before our Great Commander in the Judgment. (Matt. 25)
