"Know ye not that I must be about My Father's business?" (Luke 2:49)

We can say, with confidence, that Jesus was a "go-getter," He did what was expected of Him in completing His assigned tasks! Let's emulate His eagerness to do the Father's will in all things!


WHY NOT YOU?
